Manage Your Programs on findhelp

The findhelp platforms empower and support Community-Based Organizations (CBOs) to more easily and effectively help people in need of your services. One of the main ways CBOs can access this support is by creating a free account and claiming their program(s).


What is Claiming?

Claiming your program allows you to access and update your program's information, create intake screeners and eligibility assessments, review reporting and analytics tools, and more – all for free!

How Can I Claim My Programs?

Claiming is simple! Just follow these steps:

1. Go to <https://arkbluefindhelp.findhelp.com/claims>
2. Search for your program or organization within your organization's main ZIP Code;
3. A list of possible matches will appear – if any of these are your programs, you can select the claim button to the right;
4. Create a free account and verify your claim through an email (keep an eye out for that email!); and
5. After your claim is confirmed, a check mark will appear in the corner of your program's listing, to let people know it's been claimed.

Free Tools for CBOs on findhelp

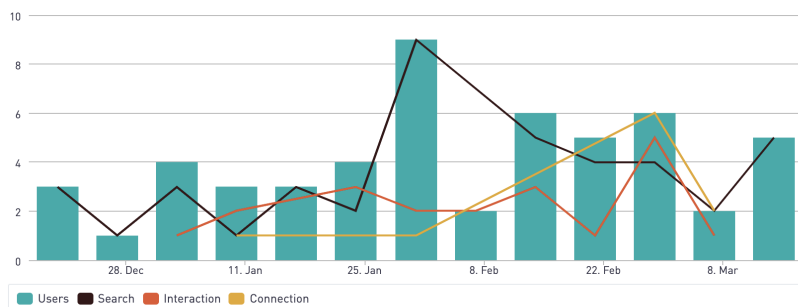
The social care network we have built in partnership with findhelp is a go-to resource for people who are in need of support or assistance. An organization that claims its programs on the site not only actively joins this network, but also gains access to a free toolkit to manage their programs' information and impact.

This Toolkit Includes:

- The ability to **edit and update** your program(s) information;
- The ability to **enable and respond to referrals** from individuals;
- **Additional intake options** such as an eligibility screening form and appointment scheduling;
- Team management tools that allow you to **give access to additional staff or volunteers**; and
- The power to **track your community impact** through free reports that can be downloaded and shared.

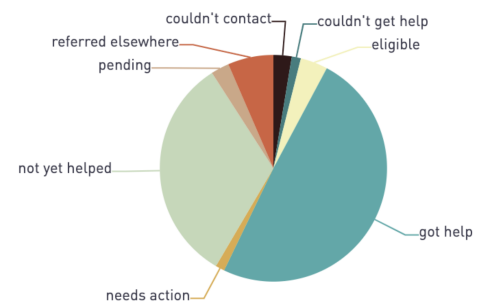
